How To Enter

Posters should be 8.5" x 11" and it will not be returned.

All or part of poster entries may be used by the orchestra in its advertising of future Young People's Concerts and Mini-Concerts.

You can use crayons; pencil crayons; or markers. It must be your own work; no computer-generated drawings or copyright material. On the back of your poster please include your name, home phone number, grade, name of school you attend, and have a parent or guardian sign it to show they agree the orchestra will become the owner of the poster, and it will not be returned.

(Don't use a marker to do any of this! It will show through!)
