



# Oakville Symphony Orchestra's Poster Contest

## WHO CAN ENTER?

All students in grades 1 to 6 in communities served by the orchestra.

Contestants will be divided into two groups:

(1) Grades 1-3; and (2) Grades 4-6

## HERE'S HOW

Draw a picture of an orchestral instrument/instruments or of someone playing an orchestral instrument/instruments. To see a variety of orchestral instruments, visit:

Posters should be 8.5" x 11"

You can use crayons; pencil crayons; or markers. It must be your own work; no computer-generated drawings or copyright material.

On the back of your poster, show your name; home phone number; school; and grade, and get a parent or guardian to sign it to show that they agree the orchestra will become the owner of the poster, and it will not be returned. (Don't use a marker to do any of this! It will show through!)

The overall winning design may be used by the orchestra in its advertising of future Young People's concerts and mini-concerts.

The overall winner will receive a quality student violin, donated by **Klaudia's Music Studio**, and the four runners-up will receive an age appropriate classical CD. The winners will be notified individually by June 30, 2009 and announced at our Young People's concert in September 2009.
